

THE VILLAGE OF HAMBURG, NY

- Construction 2005–2009




















THE VILLAGE OF HAMBURG, NY

- The original 2006 grant of \$200,000 resulted in over \$1 million in new private investment
- Subsequent grants totaling \$600,000 have returned at least an equal amount of new private investment
- Average property sale value along Route 62 increased by 169% since 2005
- Over 40 property owners assisted so far
- More than \$3.1 million in future building rehab commitments from over 30 businesses
